Talkin' with Sam Stevenson

Sam Stevenson played a set at the August jam with Jackson Fisher on harp, Peter (PJ) Dunnage on percussion, Chris Ralphs on bass, John Fraser on drums and John Drews on keys.



We spoke with Sam and asked him a few things about himself and this is what we found out...

Q1. *How long have you been living in the Bega Valley?*

I came here about 10 years ago after finishing Uni in Canberra where I studied Anthropology and Human Ecology.

Before I came down here I drifted away from the music scene for a little while, lived on a farm in Bombala, and then came down here and started a career. But you know, music seems to find you wherever you go, even if you try to get away and have a break you can't really! But now that I'm back into it I'm loving it!

Q2. *Tell me how you started playing music and when?*

It seems I've always played music. When I was growing up in Bombala my Mum was a music teacher and taught all the local kids. We had instruments everywhere in the house and we played piano, clarinet and all sorts of woodwind stuff until I finally picked up a guitar when I was about 10 or 12 and never put it down again.

Q3. *Which musos and bands did you/do you listen to?*

I grew up in the 90's and listened to the likes of *BB King, Eric Clapton, Jimi Hendrix* and bands like *Arena* were all that I cut my teeth on. Then I really started to appreciate where that all came from which is really the blues I think.

Q4. *What other bands have you played in?*

I was busking at the Thredbo Blues Festival one time when this guy, Geoff Cook, came up and gave me his card and said, 'When you get back to Canberra give me a ring'. So I did, and then got some gigs every couple of weeks at the National Press Club, playing for an hour or so before the main act who were guys such as Geoff Achison, Dutch Tilders and Tex Perkins, to name a few. I was really lucky!

Then I came down here and slowly got into the music scene down here. I played with John Drews in *The Figmentz* doing some Joe Cocker shows a few months ago.

Q5. *What do you do when you are not playing music?*

I work full time as a Manager for NGO in Cooma. This keeps me pretty busy!

Q6. *What do you think of the Candelo Blues Club, its aims and objectives, etc.?*

This is a great club. I had such a good time here today playing with Jackson Fisher, Peter Dunnage and Chris Ralphs. I'm really looking forward to coming back!

Jam rules

Jammers, please take note! To assist with an orderly jam and to enable as many jammers as possible to participate...

1. Get your name on the jam board if you wish to join a jam set. Walking up uninvited is not cool.
2. Watch the board and be ready for your set on time.
3. Tune up prior to going on.
4. Minimise your setup time. Wasted time will be deducted from your slot. You have twenty minutes so make the most of them.
5. Don't go overtime (unless and only if you are invited to by the jam co-ordinator).
6. Clear the stage promptly at the end of your set.
