DEVELOP YOUR BLUES SENSIBILITIES

But welcoming all comers does not mean we will accept repeat jam performances which do not clearly lead to the development of a blues repertoire.

If you've been invited to take a jam set and you don't yet have an understanding of, or a three-song repertoire of blues music, please don't take that as an endorsement of your non-blues offering.

Rather, it is to be understood as an encouragement to develop your blues sensibilities and come back again with a blues set under your belt.

If that is not to your liking then we thank you for participating and wish you well as you go in search of other forums in which to present your music.

The jam is not an "open mike" event where anything goes. You are invited to join or lead a jam set at the jam co-ordinator's discretion and

the only appropriate response is to embrace the blues. We want you to develop and nurture a love of blues music.

If you're willing, we'll help in any way we can. We want you to discover your inner bluesman/woman.

THE JUSTICE BUREAU TO HOST JAM

Blues On Tap will be taking a break from hosting the jam in November and giving way to *The Justice Bureau*. This 6-piece line-up features **Lucy Fisher** (vocals), **Ian Fisher** (bass), **John Drews** (keys), **Dan Morassutti** (drums), **Mike Horneman** (guitar) and **Drew Forbes** (harp).

This is a new line-up for this long-standing, well-travelled band and promises to deliver a killer set or two! This is a not-to-be-missed event.

Interestingly, this line-up can be attributed in part to connections made at the CBC jam. This is one of the great things about blues clubs and the events they sponsor.

Jam rules

Jammers, please take note! To assist with an orderly jam and to enable as many jammers as possible to participate...

1. Get your name on the jam board if you wish to join a jam set. Walking up uninvited is not cool.
2. Watch the board and be ready for your set on time.
3. Tune up prior to going on.
4. Minimise your setup time. Wasted time will be deducted from your slot. You have twenty minutes so make the most of them.
5. Don't go overtime (unless and only if you are invited to by the jam co-ordinator).
6. Clear the stage promptly at the end of your set.
